Statement of the Case

Based upon the evidence presented, the Court finds the following facts:

- 1. In or about July, 2005, plaintiff Eagle World Media, Inc. ("Eagle") entered into a contract with defendant Face2Face Animation, Inc., ("F2F") by which F2F agreed to pay Eagle a 5% (Five Percent) investment finder's fee for any investment that Eagle found and that was actually made in F2F.
- 2. Eagle found Edentify, Inc. which, as a result of Eagle's efforts, transferred 7.5 million shares of its stock to F2F, along with a warrant to purchase an additional 1 million share of Edentify stock, in exchange for rights in certain of F2F's intellectual property.
- 3. Eagle learned about these share transfers in or about September 9, 2005, when its details were disclosed in a Schedule 13D and Form 3 filed by F2F with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission and released to the public on the SEC's Edgar computer website.
 - 4. Eagles demanded its 5% finder's fee. F2F refused. This lawsuit followed. The court makes the following findings of law:
- 1. "Damages for a breach of contract are to be determined as of the time of the occurrence of the breach." 22 AM.JUR.2D "Damages," § 78, at p. 113. The instant breach occurred on or about September 9, 2005 when Edentify stock was trading at a price of 73ϕ per share. At that price, the finder's fee due to Eagle is 7.5 mlllion shares x .73 per share x .05 (5%) = \$273,750.00.

Judgment

Judgment shall be and the same is hereby entered in favor of Plaintiff Eagle World Media, Inc. and against defendant Face2Face Animation, Inc. in the amount of \$273,750.00 compensatory damages plus \$90,675.00 prejudgment interest through January 12, 2009, for a judgment in the total amount of \$364,425.00 plus daily interest from thereafter at the rate of \$75/day until the date the judgment is filed.
